The MIRANDA project closes successfully with the Info Days promoting Roma inclusion in VET

The MIRANDA project has successfully **concluded its three-year journey** (September 2023-August 2026) with the implementation of a series of Info Days at VET Schools across all participating countries during August 2026.

Organised under **Activity 5.5 – Info Days at VET Schools** within Work Package 5 (WP5), these events marked the project's final activity and celebrated the achievements and outcomes delivered throughout the project. At the same time, they promoted the accessibility and benefits of Vocational Education and Training (VET) for Roma learners.

The Info Days brought together Roma learners, VET schools and educators, Roma communities, NGOs, policymakers, educational institutions, civil society organisations, and other key stakeholders. Through presentations, informational sessions, open discussions, awareness-raising activities, and networking opportunities, participants learned about the MIRANDA project, its activities, and its key results, while also exploring educational and vocational opportunities available through VET.

Particular emphasis was placed on encouraging the participation of Roma learners in vocational education and training, strengthening cooperation between VET institutions and Roma communities, and promoting inclusion, equal opportunities, and access to education for all.

The events also served as an important platform for disseminating the project's results, resources, and educational materials, highlighting the role that inclusive VET can play in supporting the educational and professional development of Roma learners.

By successfully delivering these final Info Days, the MIRANDA consortium brings the project to a close while leaving a lasting legacy of innovative tools, educational resources, partnerships, and good practices that will continue to support Roma inclusion in education and vocational training across Europe.

The successful conclusion of MIRANDA marks the **end of a significant collaborative effort and the beginning of a sustainable impact** that will continue beyond the project's lifetime.
